

Frequency in the Majority

These charts display how frequently each justice voted in the majority in decisions filed during the period September 1, 1995, to August 31, 1996. The first chart includes all cases in which a justice voted (out of the total of 75 cases, specified above), while the second chart includes only cases decided by split votes.

Kokemoor*. **Justice Bablitch** did not vote in *Kimps v. Hill*. **Justice Steinmetz** did not vote in *Association of State Prosecutors ex rel. Feiss v. Milwaukee County*. **Justice Geske** did not vote in *State v. Gilmore* and *Wisconsin Patients Compensation Fund v. Wisconsin Health Care Liab. Ins. Plan*. All of these decisions were unanimous.
